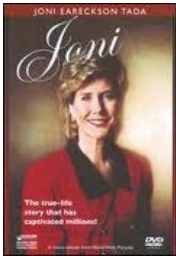

1:00am Movie: **Joni** (1979) Joni Eareckson, Bert Remsen (90 Min) Legacy TV

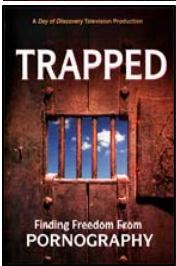

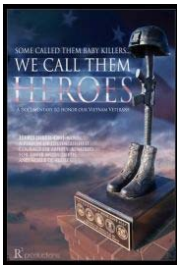




Sunday May 27
